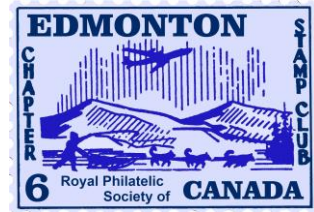


Edmonton Stamp Club Application for Membership

Administration:

The Edmonton Stamp Club is a non-profit society incorporated under the Alberta Societies Act. Its Board (officers and directors) is elected in June and its annual general meeting is held in September of each year. The Board administers the day-to-day operation of the club.

We're Connected:

The ESC is Chapter 6 of the Royal Philatelic Society of Canada and is also a Chapter of the American Philatelic Society and the Northwest Federation of Stamp Clubs. Our members can connect you to many other specialist philatelic organizations, including the British North America Philatelic Society.

Membership:

The membership year is July 1 to June 30, with fees payable in advance as follows:

Full membership: \$ 30.00

Family membership: \$ 40.00

There is a one-time fee of \$8.00 for the cost of a name tag.

Meetings:

Our Monday evening meetings start about 6:00 p.m., with time to socialize, to examine the circuit books, silent auction lots and major auction lots prior to the start of the announcements at 7:00 p.m. Following the announcements, a brief program is held (often a talk given by a club member) and the meeting concludes with the major auction, which consists of members' items and estate auction items. The meetings conclude by 9:30 p.m.

Bulletin:

The club publishes the **Bulletin** (newsletter) about ten times a year. There's information about club activities and members as well as about their collecting discoveries and interests. This newsletter is included in the membership fee. A free sample is available upon request.

Shows:

The Edmonton Stamp Club normally puts on its Spring Show about the end of March or early April every year. This is one of only three national level shows in Canada. There are competitive exhibits, dealers, and activities for youth collectors. Also, in mid-September, dealers host a Fall Stamp Market, featuring a bourse but no exhibits or other events.

Estates:

The club can assist with the disposition of philatelic estates, either directly through the club auction or by providing advice.
